

Avis Borough Council held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, January 4, 2021. Stover presiding with Mayor Harter and members Raab, Brooks, Gordon, Herman and Christian present.

Motion by A. Brooks to accept the regular minutes and the executive session minutes of the December 7, 2021 meeting, seconded by J. Raab and so carried with all Council voting in favor.

Motion by A. Brooks to pay the bills as so presented, seconded by M. Herman and so carried with all Council voting in favor . General Account \$7,233.21 Sewer Account \$3,604.61

Matt Stover and Ken Leitch were at the meeting representing the fire company. They provided Council with a list of the line officers for 2021 as well as a list of the relief officers for 2021. They also provided Council with a list of all incidences for the year 2021. They thanked Council for their support of the fire company. A. Brooks spoke to them regarding the recreation committee and fundraising for new Christmas lights. She thought that perhaps together they could come up with some fundraising events that could benefit both the fire company and the recreation committee. They invited her to a meeting so that she could discuss this with the members.

A . Uhler, Borough Engineer, told Council that he has received the repaired flow meter back and that he will be getting with Ethan to get it installed. A. Brooks asked him if he has heard of any grant money out there. He is going to look around and see if he can find some so that we could continue with the park project. .

K. Barger, Zoning and Codes Officer, was asked about the issue at the Methodist Church regarding run off. He stated that as of now the run off goes into the parking lot of the church. He will keep an eye on it and if it becomes a borough issue something will need to be done.

There was also much discussion regarding snow storms and trying to get the plow through certain streets when there are cars parked on both sides. Everyone was asked to think about this and it would get discussed further at the February meeting.

E. Hughes, Supervisor, asked if it was ok that his wife ride along with him when he is out plowing. Council stated that it was okay with them for her to ride along.

A. Brooks stated that the Christmas contest was completed and that the winners were: Tyler Eck – best door, Linda Danis – reason for the season and Lori Aungts – for best decorated house. The judges were Sue Stover, Connie Pifer and Julie Brennan. A. Brooks went on to say that the borough resident, Linda Danis is willing to help with fundraising for new lights. The lights they are talking about are the two banners at each end of town.
