

Avis Borough Council held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 3, 2019. Stover presiding with Mayor Harter and members Raab, Brooks, Gordon, Herman, Aungst and Christian present.

Motion by A. Brooks to accept the minutes of the May 6, 2019 meeting, seconded by J. Raab and so carried with all Council voting in favor.

Motion by A. Brooks to pay the bills as so presented with one additional bill payable to Eileen Hughes, seconded by J. Raab and so carried with all Council voting in favor.

There was one mowing bid to be opened. The bid was from Turf Cutter in the amount of \$350.00 per mowing. A. Brooks made a motion to accept this bid with a second by E. Christian and so carried with all Council voting in favor.

Mayor E. Harter went over the police report for April and May, copies attached hereto.

E. Hughes, supervisor, stated that there is a tree at the playground/park that needs to come down. He stated that they are not able to do it. D. Aungst made a motion to get in touch with Mike Saar to see if he could get it down. A. Brooks seconded with all Council voting in favor. This tree needs taken down immediately.

J. Raab stated that sewer work on Lincoln Avenue needs to be completed. The Borough received an estimate for this work from Charles Construction in the amount of \$41,552.00. This would include installing 400' of 6" under-grain and 965 square yards of amosite from Washington to Blvd. This has been tabled until the Street Committee has had an opportunity to investigate this further.

The Borough has also received an estimate for the repair of the intersection at Fairveiv and Smith Streets in the amount of \$3,931.00.

J. Raab also stated that he would like to look into getting another piece of equipment. He would like to purchase a skid steerer with implements to help aid the employees in their job.

A Brooks asked who dug up the road at W. Park and Prospect Streets. She was told that the Borough did that and that they will get it fixed.

A Brooks also stated that she is still moving forward with the web-site. She asked about posting the minutes on the web-site. T. Gordon made a motion to have the minutes posted with a second by J. Raab and so carried with all Council voting in favor.

T. Gordon went over a change to the Ordinance Amending Chapter 226 regarding signage. The change is to define the color the sign needs to be. J. Raab made a motion to adopt Ordinance Number 2019-297 with a second by D. Aungst and so carried with all Council voting in favor. Zoning Officer will prepare a letter to mail to Borough residents explaining this change and will put it in with the 2020 sewer book mailing.

E. Christian stated that the community yard sale day is this Saturday, June 8th.

A. Uhler, Borough Engineer, asked if the Borough has heard anything further from the State regarding the variance request for the boiler. The Borough has not heard anything. He stated that he has a meeting scheduled with Avis Building Supply on Wednesday, June 5th @ 4:00 regarding their sewer hook-up. He would also like to schedule a meeting with E. Hughes

and J. Raab regarding the sewer mains. D. Aungst asked A. Uhler about an updated map showing the sewer work. A. Uhler does not have an updated map printed yet.

A Brooks thanked E. Hughes for getting the tree down at the tank. Now, it needs to be replaced with something.

Borough resident, Darryl McHenry, was at the meeting regarding trees at his mother's house at 415 W. Martin. He was told that the trees were the property owners' responsibility.

E. Hughes state that Pine Creek Township used their street sweeper and swept Central Avenue prior to the carnival. D. Aungst made a motion to get a \$50.00 OIP card as a thank you to them, J. Raab seconded and so carried with all Council voting in favor.

D. Winkelman, Chief, told Council that he thinks that Avis has the best carnival parade in the area.
