At 7:20 Council went into Executive Session. At that time auditors Klein & Rizzo went over the 2019 audit report. Out of Executive Session at 8:40. D. Aungst made a motion to accept the 2019 audit report with a second by J. Raab and so carried with all Council voting in favor.
